The submitter **AND ONLY THE SUBMITTER** of the paper has access in the [Navigation Center](#) to upload the final paper.

FINAL PAPER PREPARATION:

1. Remember to restore author names and affiliations, acknowledgments, and other material removed from the initial submission for double-blind review compliance.
2. Create a .PDF file of the paper.
3. Run the paper through the IEEE eXpress system to make sure it is compliant. The paper has to be compliant or you will receive an email asking you to make it compliant.

An Online confirmation will be displayed and an email confirmation will be sent verifying your account setup.

 - c. If you have any questions about the copyright form, please contact IEEE directly.

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7. Enter Speaker Bio – **Due 7 March.** Enter a bio for the speaker in the box. Once you have completed this task the “Red X” will turn into a “Blue Check”.
8. Once you have completed steps 3, 4 and 5 you will then be able to upload the final paper to the system – **Due 7 March.** Click the link to the “Final Paper”, click the “choose file” button and browse for your final paper.
